### Summary of the activity




**Total time:** 3 sessions

#### Global objectives

- This activity is a continuation of the activity *Scholarships 1*.

- They are also told to present their results to the rest of the class.
- The learners will be able to work in small groups.
- The learner will be able to use his/her communicative skills.
- The learner will be able to practice his/her skills related to the use of ICT.

Timing	Skills	Preparation and material	Procedure
45'		Activity 1	<p>At this point, students are requested to focus on a single scholarship or grant.</p> <p>In the same way, they will have to study all the necessary steps in order to apply for this scholarship or grant.</p>
45' (+ Homework)		Activity 2	<p>Students prepare their conclusions to show them to the rest of the class.</p> <p>They are free to use any kind of support, materials and format for the presentation.</p> <p>Some homework could be also required for this activity.</p>
45'		Activity 3	<p>Conclusions are presented to the rest of the class.</p> <p>Depending on the number of students, more than one session could be required.</p>
