Summary of the activity



Total time: 2 sessions

Level: all levels

All languages

Global objectives

- This activity could be proposed as a continuation of the activity “Studying abroad”.
- In this activity, students are intended to find existing opportunities to obtain scholarships and grants. They will have to cooperate and communicate investigating about scholarships using the existing ICT resources.
- The learners will be able to work in small groups.
- The learner will be able to use his/her communicative skills.
- The learner will be able to practice his/her skills related to the use of ICT.

Timing	Skills	Preparation and material	Procedure
45'		Activity 1	Learners work individually. They are asked to find which scholarships or grants are offered in their country to continue their studies abroad.
45'		Activity 2	Students have to find other people in their class with a similar profile and interests. (We will try to form groups of 3 or 4 students) They are told to exchange the information they collected, and to decide which the best resources are.
